Relicensure/Salary Advancement Credit

With regards to CDE licensure renewal, licensing renewal credit must now be related to:

- a. Your endorsement area
- b. A potential added endorsement area
- c. Literacy
- d. Numeracy
- e. Increasing your skills and competence in the delivery of instruction in your existing or potential endorsement areas. This form of renewal credit may include methodology classes.

Include the original certificate of attendance from the event. After approval, you will receive the appropriate APS transcript. Semester hours can be calculated as follows: every 7.5 clock hours equal 0.5 semester hours.
